There are many different superstitions (迷信) and most people believe at least one or two of them. Many people are superstitious about numbers. They think that there are lucky numbers and unlucky numbers. The number 11 is often considered an unlucky number and so the parts of the world, buildings have no 11th floor and streets have no houses with the number 11. In Japan, 11 is considered a lucky number because in Japanese, the word "11" is pronounced "11" which means "the end of the world". The Japanese never use gifts of 11. In fact, they give gifts of 11 or 11 of anything.

What are the lucky numbers? Seven is a lucky number in many places, and it is considered a lucky number in Japan and China. In China, it is considered a lucky number. Westlake College in Virginia will start a laptop computer program that will allow all of its students to use laptops wherever they want.
